They are in your face. The challenge of this book is to simplify its complexities--patiently and painstakingly connecting the dots, integrating fragmentations, realigning related thoughts, and searching for the meanings of life "rooted and grounded in [God's] love." (Ephesians 3:17) Without going through the details, I followed these processes: asking God questions by reflecting, and debating within myself for answers, anticipating questions that readers might ask, and answering them not by my words but mostly by God's words. I've employed the use of underlining for emphasis and readability and bracketed information, clarifications, comments and lessons to learn.
